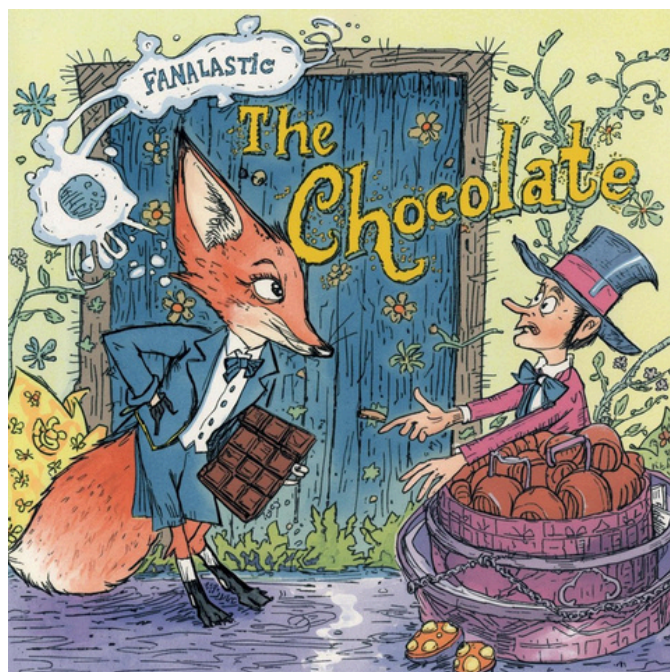

CHAPTER I.

My father had a small estate in Nottinghamshire; I was the third of five sons.
